Now is the time to plan ahead and get rid of unwanted waste in your home, garage, yard, or other parts of your property. Furniture, clothing, old shoes, tires, scraps, declutter your home and make room for something new. **To participate in Bridgeview's Spring Cleanup Day simply bring any number of garbage or bulk items to the curb before 6 A.M. on May 11th.**

Oil or gasoline must be drained from lawnmowers, trimmers, or other types of machines. Refrigerators & freezers must be drained. Paint cans must be dried using sand or kitty litter before disposal. All non-bulk items must be bagged or boxed. E-Waste such as old TV's, computers, stereos, etc. can be put out on the curb for this day only. 

Hydrant Flushing and Leak Testing

Trustee Higginson, Chair of Fire Safety Committee, reports that the Village of Bridgeview continues to ensure that our fire hydrants are fully operable by flushing and testing for leaks in their water lines. This routine maintenance involves removing sediments from the water lines so that hydrants maintain the proper water flow and pressure required for emergency situations. Hydrant flushing is currently underway from 79th Street south to 103rd Street. The Village of Bridgeview stays true to its commitment of fully serving residents by ensuring that keeping Bridgeview's water system safe and reaffirming Bridgeview's emergency preparedness are always top priorities.




Water flows from a Bridgeview fire hydrant.

Reducing Flooding with Smoke Testing

Trustee Gary Lewis, Chair of Public Works Committee, announces that as part of the Smoke Testing and Manhole Inspection Project, the Village of Bridgeview conducted smoke testing in the Bridgeview sanitary sewer system west of the train tracks in February as required by the Metropolitan Water Reclamation District (MWRD).

Smoke testing is a simple method of locating openings in the sanitary sewer system that allow surface rainwater runoff to enter the sanitary sewers. Air combined with non-toxic smoke is forced into the sewers at manholes, usually located in the street, filling the system. If there are leaks in or impropthe sanitary sewer system. Smoke will appear where there are defects in the main sewer line or sewer service connections, which identifies the infiltration of rainwater. The safe smoke testing process detects leaks and thus enables the Village to maintain the safe operation of Bridgeview's sanitary sewer system by fixing those leaks and preventing basement back-ups and sanitary sewer street overflows.

Trustee Gary Lewis commented on the vital work being done to maintain Bridgeview's flood preparedness. "Pro-actively identifying problematic areas in our system is a must to reduce er connections to the sanitary sewer the threat of major issues and to secure

WATER TOWER WORK **BEGINS THIS JUNE!**

Work to resurface and paint the Bridgeview Water Tower is starting July 15th. The project includes cleaning, repairing, and resurfacing the interior of the water tower, removing and reinstalling affixed cell phone relays, and the complete cleaning and repainting of the tower's exterior.

Updating the Bridgeview Water Tower will round out the millions of dollars of investments in Bridgeview's

water infrastructure that included repairs and upgrades to the ground-level and underground water tanks as well as the removal of 100% of lead pipes in our village. The Water Tower is expected to be completed by the end of 2024, ensuring Bridgeview's water infrastructure remains able to store and transport clean, safe drinking water for the entire community for years to come.

Call JULIE Before You Dig!

Planting, building, adding, or fixing anything outdoors? Know what's below. Get your underground utility lines marked before you start digging. It's a FREE service that could save you time, costly utility repairs, and even your life. The danger of hitting a gas line, electricity line, water line, etc. is real. Neither you nor your neighbors will want to lose a critical service due to an avoidable mistake. Online or over the phone, JULIE's request system is available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. Follow the steps below before digging.

• After you receive email confirmation from JULIE, local utility company members locate and mark underground utility lines with colored

- Premark your dig area with white paint, stakes, or flags.
- Submit a request online or call 811. The law requires you contact JULIE
- paint and flags.
- Respect the markings and don't remove them until digging is finished.
- Dig carefully and use hand tools when digging within 18 inches of a marked underground line. Contact JULIE and your utility company if you may have struck a line.
