Bridgeview's 2026 Road to Repavement

The Bridgeview Street Resurfacing Project continues in 2026 with new road repaving to improve our infrastructure and beautify our community. Work on the first streets will begin soon, with a total of nearly two miles of streets to be repaved by the end of the year. Curbs, sidewalks, and storm sewers will be updated as needed when roads are being repaved to efficiently upgrade our infrastructure throughout the Village.

Roads already being repaved this year include:

- Stickney - 79th to 77th St.
- 77th St. - Sholer to Roberts Road
- 80th St. - 7700 to 78th Ave.
- 83rd St. - Harlem to Oketo Ave.
- Homestead Lane - 91st to Stanford Dr.
- Beloit Ave. - 91st to 92nd St.

At a recent Village Board Meeting, Trustee Gary Lewis, Chairman of the Public Works Committee, detailed the latest plans for the upcoming transportation infrastructure work. "The Village of Bridgeview will continue to modernize our roads this year. In 2026, the Village will

be investing over \$1,000,000 in road improvements to support safe driving and beautification in our community. The work on our roads, curbs, and sidewalks will be efficiently paired with the updating of our sewer system to ensure that we continue improving our flood preparedness. The cost of the infrastructure work is well worth the return of saving lives, property,

and money. Modernizing our roads and sewers will safely bring our well-balanced community into the future."

The Bridgeview Street Resurfacing Project has been vital to enhancing the infrastructure of the Village, and Bridgeview is committed to ensuring that roads and sidewalks are safe and beautiful for many years to come.

Harlem Avenue HEROES

24 hours per day, 365 days a year, Bridgeview honors our military heroes with public banners. These are residents of Bridgeview and family members of Bridgeview residents who have served in the military.

Mayor Steven Landek said, "Currently there are 40 banners of Patriots on Harlem Avenue. This is a salute to real people who we have known and loved, who have served in the military to really protect democracy." This is the 4th year of the program, and as the banners are damaged by the weather, Bridgeview rushes to replace them.

Bridgeview's Year-Round Chipper Service

The Village of Bridgeview provides free chipping service all year as weather permits. Branches must be stacked no higher than 3 feet at the curb with cut ends facing the street.

When chipper service is available, the weekly schedule is as follows:

- **Monday:** North of 87th Street, West of tracks
- **Tuesday:** North of 87th Street, East of Tracks
- **Wednesday:** South of 87th Street

When looking to use the Bridgeview Chipper Service,

DO

1. DO Cut your branches; only branches cut by Bridgeview homeowners will be chipped; Contractors cutting or trimming branches

2. DO Face the cut ends of tree limbs towards the street and stack them along the parkway
3. DO Keep the length of branches fewer than 10 ft. and slimmer than 4 inches in diameter

DON'T

- A. DON'T Put tree stumps or bushes with roots in branch piles
- B. DON'T Bundle branches or include vines in the branches as the vines may become entangled with workers and endanger them
- C. DON'T Deposit grass clippings, leaves, or other debris in the branch pile or on the street – [use the Blue Village of Bridgeview Yard Waste Can for these items!](#)

Emergency Siren Testing



The National Weather Service, under the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) of the federal government, declared Bridgeview STORM READY! Thanks to the efforts of Fire Chief Keith Grzadziel and Water Plant Operator William Green, Bridgeview can now display our StormReady certification!

Being StormReady means Bridgeview has:

- Established a 24-hour warning point and emergency operations center;
- Redundant communications systems to receive severe weather forecasts and warnings and to alert the public.
- Created a system that monitors local weather conditions;
- Promoted the importance of public readiness through community seminars;
- Developed a formal hazardous weather plan, which includes training severe weather spotters and holding emergency exercises.

Bridgeview's outdoor warning siren system — a critical part of the community's severe weather alert infrastructure — has recently undergone upgrades and continues to be maintained to ensure residents stay safe when severe weather threatens. The Village's two outdoor sirens, located at the Village Hall, and Muehe Park, now include enhanced automatic activation.

To keep the sirens in good working order, Bridgeview's warning sirens are serviced each year prior to the beginning of severe weather season. The Village of Bridgeview regularly tests the outdoor warning sirens on the first Tuesday of each month at 10:00AM. These tests help verify that the system is functioning properly and familiarize residents with the sound so that it's recognizable if activated during an actual emergency.

Residents should note that sirens are primarily intended to alert people outdoors to seek shelter. Sirens may not be heard well inside homes or businesses, especially with doors and windows closed. Because of this, sirens should not be the only source of severe weather alerts.

The Illinois Emergency Management Agency (IEMA) offers important guidance to help families and individuals stay safe during tornadoes and other severe weather events.

KEEP YOUR PETS SAFE

Registering animals with the Village ensures that pets living in your community are vaccinated against rabies. Rabies is a viral infection of the nervous system which is transmitted through the saliva of a cat or dog by biting another animal or human. Within a short amount of time, rabies will cause the affected animal or human to have swelling of the brain and lead to severe illness or death if not treated promptly.

All mammals—that means dogs, cats, possums, raccoons, coyotes and humans—are able to contract rabies. Rabies shots are administered by all

veterinarians, and they will then issue you a rabies tag. That county rabies tag number must be provided to Bridgeview before we issue a pet tag.

This is about the safety of your animal and the humans or other animals your pet will come in contact with! And if your pet gets lost, the Police Department can return them to you if they are registered. Let's enjoy summer and venture outdoors with our pets while making sure they have their rabies shot and Bridgeview pet tag. It is our responsibility to make sure our furry friends are safe and healthy!

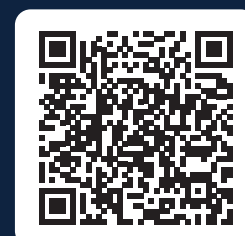

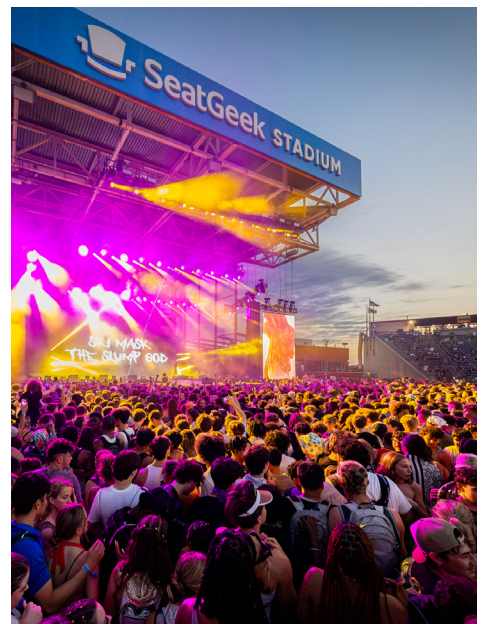
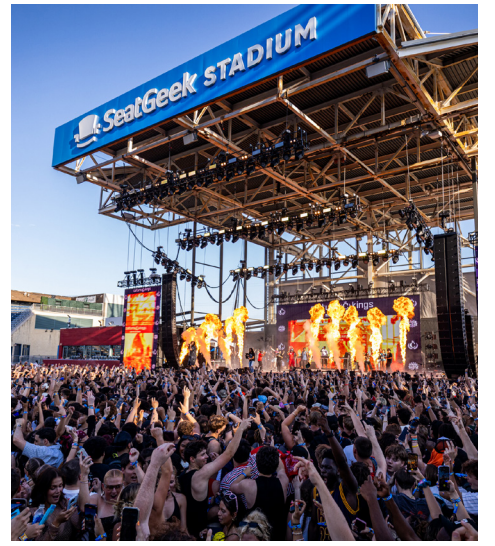

79th Street. Residential gates will be closed, and access points will be monitored to keep festival traffic out of our residential streets.

If you plan to have guests stay the night during that weekend, you must pick up guest parking passes at the Village of Bridgeview Customer Service Office. Vehicle stickers and parking passes ensure only Bridgeview residents' vehicles are parked on our streets. It's important for the safety of our residents, our Police Department, and our Fire Department to be

able to drive through Bridgeview with ease, especially during festivals.

This Summer, Bridgeview will be the place where tens of thousands come to celebrate the summer season with their favorite artists. Our diverse lineup of stadium events brings in revenue for our local businesses and benefits our entire community. 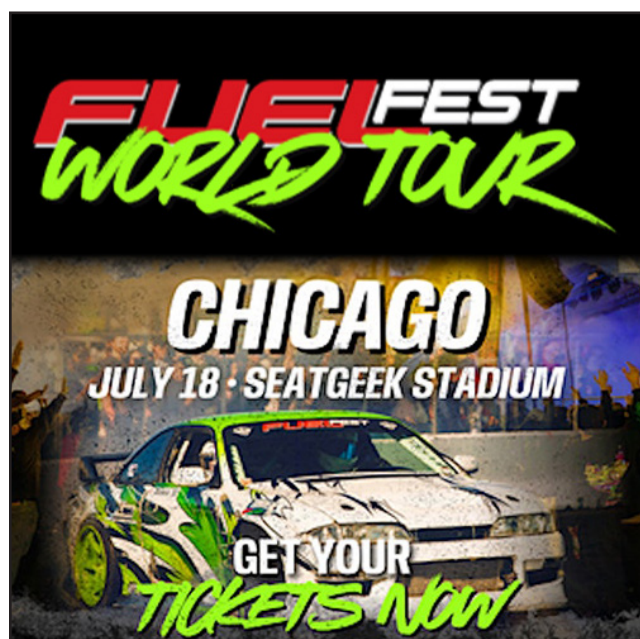

The Bridgeview library is fixing flood damage from the July summer storms, and the Children's library is getting a new floor! Children's Books and computers are still accessible on the Adult side.



82 TONS!! of Trash Removed on Cleanup Day!

The 2026 Spring Cleanup Day, the first of two days Village of Bridgeview residents get rid of unused items from their homes, garages, and yards, eliminated thousands of pounds of garbage. In total, more than 82 tons of trash (164,000 lbs.) were removed from our beautiful community on Saturday, April 18th! 82 tons is equal to the weight of about 4 whale sharks, the largest living fish in the world, meaning people who participated in the event were left with more space and less waste in their homes.

Residents could be seen sweeping, carrying garbage bags, and moving heavy objects as they lined up their items for disposal on the street curb the night before. Everything from broken electronics and worn-out furniture to useless tires and old paint cans could be seen arranged along the curbside and properly prepared for removal. This year's tonnage is ten tons fewer than last year's on Spring Cleanup Day, suggesting that there may be less waste to get rid of as residents routinely dispose of their unused objects twice each year. If you missed out on participating, start planning now for Fall Cleanup Day 2026 on Saturday, October 3rd!

Congratulations to SBC Waste Solutions, families throughout the Village, and the Bridgeview Public Works Department for their successful Cleanup Day efforts resulting in a cleaner, brighter Bridgeview.
